**TRC to hear from Residential School Survivors**  
**June 25 and 26 in Terrace, BC**

JUNE 24, 2013 – The Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada (TRC) will host a hearing at Terrace, BC, on Tuesday, June 25 and Wednesday, June 26, 2013.

The hearing will provide an opportunity for Survivors and others affected by the Indian Residential Schools to share their experiences with Commissioner Marie Wilson, community members and anyone else who would like to learn about and bear witness to the schools' legacy.

It is free to the public, and everyone is encouraged to attend. Those who want to make a private statement to the Commission will also be able to do so. Health support workers will be on hand.

The hearing will be held each day from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. PDT at Kitsumkalum Hall. It will be streamed live at [www.trc.ca](http://www.trc.ca).

The Truth and Reconciliation Commission is an independent commission established as a result of the 2007 Indian Residential Schools Settlement Agreement. Its mandate is to inform all Canadians about what happened in the 150-year history of the residential schools, and to guide and inspire a process of reconciliation and renewed relationships based on mutual understanding and respect.
